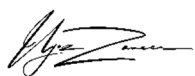

Common Social Media Mistakes That Limit Opportunities

1. Profile Foundation Mistakes

Incomplete or Outdated Profiles:

- Using old photos that don't represent your current appearance
- Missing or generic bio information
- Inconsistent information across platforms
- Lack of clear contact methods

Poor Photo Selection:

- Blurry or low-quality images
- Group photos where you're difficult to identify
- Inappropriate or unprofessional images mixed with professional content
- Photos that don't showcase your personality or interests

Bio and Description Errors:

- Generic or cliché descriptions
- Focusing only on work or only on personal interests
- Missing key information about your values or interests
- Unclear about what you're seeking in connections

2. Content Strategy Mistakes

Oversharing Personal Information:

- Posting about relationship drama or personal conflicts
- Sharing financial information or complaints about money
- Revealing private family matters or intimate details

- Location sharing that compromises safety

Negative or Controversial Content:

- Complaining frequently about work, life, or people
- Engaging in political arguments or controversial debates
- Posting content that could be offensive to potential connections
- Sharing unverified information or conspiracy theories

Inconsistent Posting Patterns:

- Long periods of inactivity followed by spam posting
- Posting only professional content on personal platforms
- Mixing inappropriate personal content with professional updates
- Failing to engage with others' content while expecting engagement

3. Engagement and Interaction Mistakes

Poor Communication Habits:

- Responding with one-word answers or generic comments
